TEEN PROGRAMS SLATED AT LIBRARY

Jan. 6, First Friday Art Club: Found Object Jewelry, 3:30-5 pm | Turn junk and found objects into stunning wearable art. Bring your own objects like wires, tubes, etc. to add to the mix.

Jan. 13, Teen Cooking Club: Cream and Breakfast, 3:30-5:30 p.m. | Start the New Year off with the first meal of the day, breakfast. Expect a visit from the Steuben County Dairy Princess to share a recipe with milk or cream.

Jan. 20, Book & Word Arts: A Creativity Clinic for Wordsmiths and Booklovers, 3:30-5:30 p.m. | Chaos: Top Chef for people who prefer to cook with nouns and verbs. Includes 45 minute workshop and 75 minute creative studio. Make your own magnetized poetry kit during studio time and turn random selections of words into impromptu verse. **Ages 12 and older.**

Feb. 3, First Friday Art Club: Duck™ Tape Fashions, 3:30-5 p.m. | Turn utility into fashion with an array of duct tapes in many colors and prints. Garments, bags and wallets will be the focus.

Feb. 10, Teen Cooking Club: Mardi Gras, 3:30-5:30 p.m. | Celebrate Mardi Gras in SSCL Style. Learn a few traditions of Mardi Gras along the way.

Feb. 17, Book & Word Arts: A Creativity Clinic for Wordsmiths and Booklovers, 3:30-5:30 p.m. | Storyteller: Use your memories to tell stories. Learn new ways of uncovering stories. Create cooperative stories through found poetry and correspondence exercises. . Includes

45 minute workshop and 75 minute creative studio. Create a one-of-a kind handmade book during studio time. **Ages 12 and older.**

March 2, First Friday Art Club: Mache, 3:30-5 p.m. | Paper Mache is a great sculptural technique. Consider making a solid object or a hollow, functional design. Dress in clothes you don't mind getting messy.

March 9, Teen Cooking Club: Saint Paddy in SSCL, 3:30-5:30 p.m. | Honor the spirit of Saint Patrick with green goodies and Irish specialties.

March 16, Book & Word Arts: A Creativity Clinic for Wordsmiths and Booklovers, 3:30-5:30 p.m. | HeartMap: Like a geographic map, a heart map is valuable in navigation. Draw your heart map to understand your own natural resources and values. Includes 45 minute workshop and 75 minute creative studio. During studio time you can choose between creating a handmade chapter journal and creating a blog in which to develop the themes of your heart map.
