FIRST FRIDAY ART CLUB CONTINUES AT LIBRARY

The First Friday Art Club will be held April 5, May 3 and June 7 from 3:30-5 p.m. at the Southeast Steuben County Library, except where noted*. This is a program that introduces teens, ages 10 and older, to different types of art each month. The schedule is as follows.

April 5 | Recycled Mosaic Stepping Stones

Create a garden mosaic stepping stone using recycled and repurposed glass and ceramics to create a design. Designs will be permanently set in concrete.

May 3 | Zentangle with The Crafting Cottage

Crafting Cottage owner Georgiana MacMahon will lead this drawing technique class. Zentangle is a technique where repeated patterns evolve into a completed work of art. Everyone will take home their own masterpiece.

*June 7 from 3: 30-5: 30 p.m. This program will be held at The Studio of The Corning Museum of Glass | Sandblast Glass at The Studio of The Corning Museum of Glass Try a glass sandblasting project and take a tour through the museum. Participants will also watch a "You Design It," Hot Glass Show to finalize this glassy experience. All participants are encouraged to create a glass design for the "You Design It" portion of this trip. Turn your design in to the Children's Desk at the library by June 5. One design will be chosen for creation at The Studio on June 7. Students will meet at The Studio of The Corning Museum of Glass promptly at 3: 30pm. Parents or guardians should pick up their children promptly at 5: 30pm.
