Jan. 16 and March 27 | Digital Music. Learn to download digital music to a PC or Mac computer. You'll also learn to organize your music, listen to it and transfer it to a portable device using iTunes.

Jan. 23, Feb. 20 and March 6 | Meet the iPad. This workshop offers an overview of how to use an iPad including screen navigation, searching and downloading apps and using those apps to have the most fun possible.

Jan. 30 and March 13 | Photos & Computers. Learn to transfer photos from your digital camera to a computer, as well as how to modify and save those images.

Feb. 6 | Entertainment Apps. Apples and Androids aren't just for work. They're for fun, too. Learn all about fun apps for games, movies and music during this workshop.

Feb. 13 | Learn to use Microsoft Excel. This workshop will assist new Excel users in gaining control of using this spreadsheet software.

Feb. 27 | Email. It's been around since the '90s but not everyone is on board. If you are new to email, this workshop is for you. Learn basic tips to create, send, receive and organize your email.
